

Post-Doctoral Fellowship 2024-2025

The University of New Mexico's Center for Regional Studies (CRS) is pleased to announce the availability of a post-doctoral research fellow position. The Center for Regional Studies is a multidisciplinary outreach center designed to enhance the work of the University of New Mexico through student fellowships, research, program funding, visiting scholars, digital media and other projects with a particular emphasis on activities that increase our understanding of New Mexico, the Southwest, Indigenous communities, the U.S. Mexico Borderlands, and the Americas.

The CRS post-doctoral research fellow position is a 12-month appointment (July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025) open to a UNM Ph.D. graduate who will have completed their degree prior to July 1, 2024. The position will be solely with CRS. The post-doctoral fellow must be in residence for the duration of the appointment period, submit a mid-term report by December 15, 2024, as well as a final report to the CRS Director by July 31, 2025, and present their research to UNM and broader community near completion of the appointment.

Stipend/Resources:

- The stipend is \$48,000 (for 12-month appointment).
- Additional \$2,000 provided for research, travel, and related expenses
- CRS will provide office space
- CRS will provide a faculty mentor to work with on research

Qualifications:

- Ph.D. completed prior to July 1, 2024
- Area of study in an academic discipline aligned with the [CRS mission](#) and areas of research
- Promise for original scholarship in an area associated with the CRS mission

Application Materials:

Complete applications will include the following:

- Personal statement (3-5 pages) that addresses educational goals, professional plans, and interest in the post-doctoral research fellowship as it relates to the [CRS mission](#)
- Research plan (3-5 pages) for the 12-month post-doctoral fellowship appointment
- Current curriculum vitae (CV)
- One writing sample (10-20 pages) of original work (i.e. dissertation chapter, article, report)

Supporting Letters:

In addition, three recommendation letters from faculty in the applicant's academic home department or dissertation committee should be requested by the student. These letters are not part of the application packet and must be submitted by the faculty member directly to the Center for Regional Studies by **November 3, 2023**; crsunm@unm.edu .
