

## CRS Post-Doctoral Research Fellowship 2025-2026 Applications due January 10, 2025

The University of New Mexico's Center for Regional Studies (CRS) is pleased to announce the availability of a postdoctoral research fellowship. The Center for Regional Studies is a multidisciplinary outreach center designed to enhance the work of the University of New Mexico through student fellowships, research, program funding, visiting scholars, digital media and other projects with a particular emphasis on activities that increase our understanding of New Mexico, the U.S. Mexico Borderlands, Indigenous communities, and the Americas.

The post-doctoral research fellow position is a 12-month appointment (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026) open to a UNM Ph.D. or M.F.A. graduate from 2024 to 2025. The position will be solely with CRS with no tenure home. The post-doctoral research fellow must be in residence for the duration of the appointment period, present their research to the UNM and broader larger community near completion of the appointment, and submit a final report to the CRS Director by July 31, 2026.

## Stipend/Resources:

- The award will be \$50,000 (12-monthly payments).
- A \$2,000 stipend will be provided for research, travel, and related expenses.
- CRS will provide office space.

## **Qualifications:**

- Ph.D. or M.F.A. completed prior to July 1, 2025
- Area of study in an academic discipline aligned with the CRS mission and areas of research
- Promise for original scholarship in an area associated with the CRS mission

## **Application Materials:**

Completed applications must include the following:

- Current curriculum vitae (CV)
- Personal statement (3-5 pages) that addresses educational goals, professional plans, and interest in the Post-doctoral research fellowship as it relates to the CRS mission
- Research plan (3-5 pages) for the 12-month appointment
- One Writing sample (10-20 pages) of original work (i.e. dissertation chapter, article, report)
- Three recommendation letters from faculty in home department or dissertation committee
